**Policy Name:** Graduate Tuition Scholarships--College of Engineering Students

**I. PURPOSE**

To allow for consistent granting of graduate tuition scholarships for students in the College of Engineering.

**II. POLICY**

The College of Engineering will provide tuition scholarships consistent with the College Faculty Obligation for Graduate Tuition Costs Policy for all graduate students matriculating in one of its programs receiving research-focused funding.

**III. ELIGIBLE GRADUATE STUDENT CATEGORIES**

**College of Engineering Graduate Students** receiving a stipend for research related work may fall under many headings (**Research Assistants, Graduate Assistants, Fellows, etc.**). Any such student receiving a stipend for work related to his/her graduate efforts (i.e., matriculation/discipline) is eligible to receive a full tuition scholarship.

**College of Engineering Graduate Students** receiving a stipend from a fellowship that is not funded by the College (whether paid directly to them or through the University) are eligible to receive a tuition scholarship for any portion of tuition not covered by the fellowship budget.

**IV. INELIGIBLE GRADUATE STUDENT CATEGORIES**

**College of Engineering Graduate Students** funded by non-college work (i.e., students who find pay for work in a non-college department) that is not related to their degree are not eligible for a tuition scholarship.

**V. FUNDING FOR SCHOLARSHIP**

The tuition scholarship will be funded in accordance with the Faculty Obligation for Graduate Tuition Costs Policy. The source of funds used for the stipend is irrelevant.
